Googlebooks go on sale in Australia on 5 October from \$2,299, but Google says they aren't ready for business fleets yet

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- ☐ **Hold off on buying Googlebooks for staff.** Google says management tools for Googlebooks start rolling out in the second half of 2027.
 - ☐ **Decide whether Workspace accounts can sign in.** In Google Endpoint Management, your Workspace admin controls whether staff can use a managed Workspace account on a Googlebook.
 - ☐ **Check the Auto Update date of each Chromebook you own.** Google keeps updating current Chromebooks until those dates or mid-2034, whichever comes first, and says many newer models can move to Googlebook OS.
 - ☐ **Check which Google account gets the free AI Pro year.** The offer terms don't say whether it covers Workspace accounts, so keep business files in your Workspace storage.
 - ☐ **Set a reminder before the free AI Pro year ends.** After 12 months it costs A\$32.99 a month, or the then-current price, unless you cancel.
 - ☐ **Try your Office files on a Googlebook before relying on it for work.** Google says Word, Excel, Outlook and PowerPoint files open through the Microsoft 365 app, with more features on a Microsoft 365 subscription.
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
